The Citizens' Constable Academy speakers, who are experts in their fields, provide lectures, demonstrations, tours, and hands-on activities for Academy participants. The overall objective of the Academy is to provide citizens with sound and accurate information about the Galveston County Constables Office Precinct 7 and the civil and criminal justice process so that citizens are able to make informed decisions when issues of civil matters or involve the police department or police activity. It is the office's hope that participants in the Citizens' Constable Academy will share their experiences and learned information with family, friends, co-workers, and their community to further improve and strengthen community-police relations.

What is the course curriculum?

Each week, a different discipline or area of the Galveston County Constables Office Precinct 7 is presented. Examples include, but are not limited to: Warrants Division, Civil Division, Gangs are just a few topics.

When will the next Citizens' Constable Academy begin, what location and what is the cost?

The Academy involves a 24 hour block of instruction, consisting of a three-hour class, one day a week for 8 weeks. The times of the class are usually 6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. The first day of class is Orientation and the last day is Graduation.
