Man sought for threatening to kill Judge, Attorney.

Galveston County Sheriff's Office Detectives opened an investigation last Friday into allegations that a man threatened the lives of his lawyer and a judge.

Vincent Michael Glorioso, 52, of Houston, was reportedly involved in a lawsuit previously heard in a Galveston State District Court. After losing suit, Glorioso apparently called another attorney and made direct threats against the lives his previous attorney and the judge involved in his case.

Arrest warrants were issued Friday, charging Glorioso with two counts of felony Retaliation. He was known to reside in the 6300 block of Beverly Hill st. in Houston, but his current whereabouts is unknown.
